

**ENID SOCCER CLUB**  
**U10 & U12 POST SEASON TOURNAMENT RULES**  
**Effective 11-14-2006**

- Tournament seeding will follow all regular season games played within the set dates.
- Ties for tournament seeding will be broken by using goals against and then a coin toss.
- Tournament schedule will be posted on the Web site and at the soccer complex (referee shack and/or portable building), two days following the last regular season game.
- Pool-play games will normally be played on the Saturday of the tournament (some games may be on Friday). Semifinals and finals will be played on Sunday. Sunday games will not begin before 1:00 p.m.
- There will be no rescheduling of tournament games. Teams unable to play at their scheduled times, will forfeit. **Absolutely no exceptions.**
- In case of bad weather, only the Head Official on the fields, the Scheduler, Field Maintenance or President can call games off. In the event the Head Official is not available, the next person listed will make the decision.
- Pool-play games that need to be rescheduled because of weather **may** be scheduled on the Sunday semifinals and finals would have been on. No games will be scheduled before 1:00 p.m. on Sunday. The semifinals and finals will be moved to the following Saturday and Sunday if needed.
- Tournament format will **normally** be Seeded Pool play. **Depending on the number of teams participating, a semi-final round may be played** with the winner of each pool coming out for the semifinals. Second place team(s) will be used to fill any remaining semifinal positions. Winners of the semifinals will play in the finals. **If the number of teams makes pool play impractical, a round-robin or a single elimination format may be used.**
- The 10-Point system will be used for the Tournament: 6 points for a win, 3 points for a tie, 0 points for a loss, 1 point for a shut-out, and 1 point for each goal scored (up to a maximum of 3 points). Forfeits will be scored as if the score of the game was 3-0.
- Tie-breakers for going to the semifinals will be:
  - Head to Head
  - Goal Differential
  - Goals Allowed
  - 5 Penalty Kicks
  - Coin Toss
- Ties in the semifinals and finals will be decided by 2 five-minute **overtimes (not Golden Goal)**. If there is a tie following overtime, there will be **penalty kicks** per FIFA rules.
- Post-Season Tournament dates and rules will be provided with the regular season schedules.
- Teams that do not play their players at least half of the game will forfeit the game. In order for a team to forfeit, playing time must be kept by a Board Member or designated representative and must commence at the start of the match.
